Proposed Capital Projects

79th Street School was built in 1950. It serves 438 students in grades Pre-K – grade 6.

Intended Projects

- Build hot kitchen
- Building-wide air conditioning
- Upgrade wiring to CAT 6/6a to ensure optimum compatibility
- Renovate Athletic Site (Does Not Incl Playground/BB hoops)
- Repair and Reseal Pavement (Play Area)
- Parking Lot repairs
- Replace Drainage Catch Basin (NW site)
- Replace Sidewalks
- Evaluate NW corner of bldg proximity to tree roots
- Provide bollards at NE end of boiler room
- Repair or replace ADA tactile warning strips
- Evaluate Concrete Floor Water Infiltration
- Refinish Hardwood Flooring (Stage)
- Repair Exterior Wall Veneer (Repoint 50% Brick)
- Replace Acoustic Ceiling Tile - 2x4 and 12x12 inc. abatement
- Replace all millwork at all classrooms
- Provide vertical grab bars at ADA toilet
- Patch plaster (water damage)
- Upgrade handrails with extensions for ADA compliance
- Replace basketball backstops
- Provide gym divider curtain
- Provide cubicle curtain tracks at Nurse Suite
- Repair / Refurbish gymnasium wall pads
- Teacher lounge - provide interior partition wall
- Teacher lounge - provide single interior door
- Replace Aluminum Entrance System
- Replace Damaged Seating in Theater (35%)
- Replace Exterior Doors and Frames - Single
- Replace Exterior Doors and Frames - Double
- Replace Hollow Metal Doors, Rated, Pair, Single
- Replace Roof Ladders and Sheet Carpeting
- Replace Single Interior Wood Doors & Hardware (30% of total)
- Replace Toilet Partitions
- Replace VAT w/VCT, including abatement (all classrooms)
- Reset Lintels and Restore Damaged Masonry

These projects and other capital projects in the District, can only be undertaken if the referendum passes.
