Proposed Capital Projects

Niagara Falls High School was built in 1999 and opened in 2000. It serves 1,962 students in grades 9-12 and is a well-used community center.

Intended Projects

- Repair or Replace Roof
- Address HVAC Concerns
- Repair parking lots
- Repair Parking Lot Lights
- Repair Sidewalks
- Upgrade wiring to CAT 6/6a to ensure optimum compatibility
- Interior finishes: Floor & ceiling tiles at various schools
- Add dock bumpers and repair concrete at PAC
- Evaluate Concrete Basement Floor Deficiencies
- Evaluate Cracking in Interior Masonry
- Evaluate Exterior Wall Veneer (Moisture & Integrity)
- Monitor Terrazzo Cracking
- Provide roof ladders to service inaccessible roof drains
- Replace Smoke Vents & Provide new Fall-protection Guard Rails
- Replace wall pads
- Replace/Repair Rubber base
- Repair classrooms sinks

These projects and other capital projects throughout the District,

if the referendum passes.
