Basic Facts About the 3 Year Old Pre-K Program

- The program will address early school readiness skills in an effort to better prepare \bigstar children for the District's Universal Pre-K 4 year old program.
- Children who have turned 3 years of age, on or before December 1, 2016 are eligible to attend.
- \bigstar Parents are required to complete the attached Household Income Eligibility
 - Form. Students who qualify for a free/reduced lunch will be given priority in
 - the selection process. A lottery will be conducted if we receive more request that student seats available.
 - The program will be held at Harry F. Abate School.
- \bigstar TRANSPORTATION IS NOT PROVIDED.
- \bigstar Children will receive breakfast and lunch.
