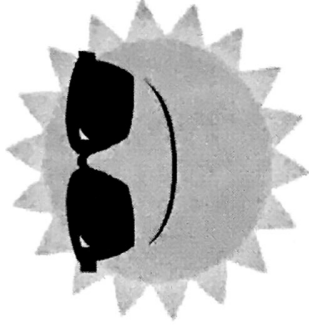

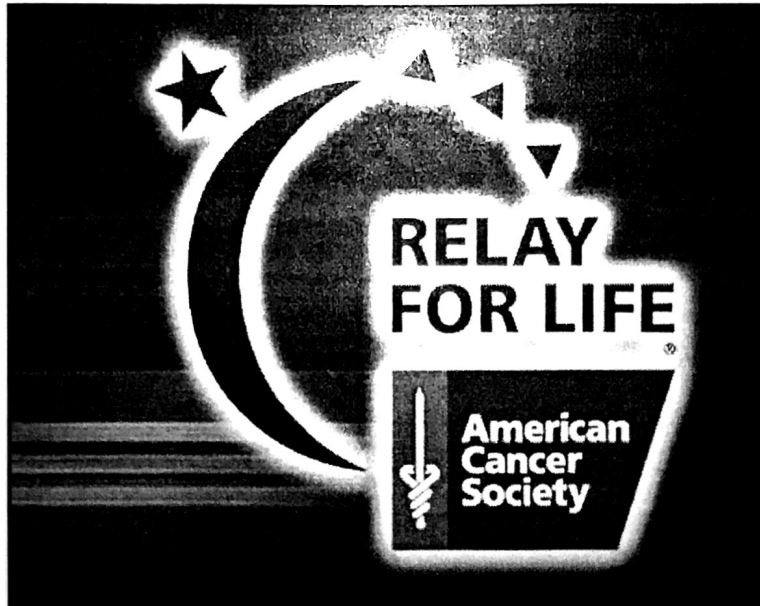


June Enrichment News
